### INTRODUCTION

The Student Affairs Department is one of the key departments within the structure of KUPU SB. It serves as a planned and systematic channel for managing student affairs beyond the academic field. The primary focus of its operations is the holistic development of students in terms of spiritual, intellectual, emotional, and physical aspects (RIEJ), as well as their talents, particularly in shaping the personal qualities required of future religious teachers. Additionally, it is responsible for managing the welfare, well-being, and safety of the students.

### Vision

### Mission

To manage Student Affairs in support of this mission, the Student Affairs Department has set several key objectives as follows:

- I. To provide motivation through comprehensive and systematic program services for the personal development of students.

- III. To provide and develop programs for personal and leadership development.

- IV. Planning, managing, and coordinating the finances of the Student Association.



- V. Planning and managing policies and regulations related to the functions and management of Student Affairs.
- VI. Planning, managing, and monitoring the election of the Student Representative Council.
- VII. Planning, managing, and monitoring student character development, spirituality, arts and culture, training, and leadership activities
